

La Fundació Josep Pla (Josep Pla Foundation) was founded in 1973 in order to promote the reading and the studies of the author's works. In 2000 the opening of the permanent exhibition 'Josep Pla 1897-1981' in the house where the author was born led to the creation of the new location for the foundation in Palafrugell. From then on the establishment of the foundation began. In 2005 Fundació Josep Pla participated in the creation of **Espais Escrits: Xarxa de Patrimoni Literari Català** (Written Spaces: the Catalan Literary Heritage Network). Since 2010, together with **Càtedra Josep Pla** (Josep Pla Professorship at the University of Girona), it has also been engaged in promoting the studies of the author's literary heritage.
